Dear parishes,

Many of you have shown commitment and support to the victims in Myanmar, both through prayer and donations.

As of 2 April, more than 2,000 people have been confirmed dead, nearly 4,000 are injured and several hundred are still missing. The Church in Myanmar is contributing to the best of its ability, but the effort is demanding due to destroyed infrastructure, lack of fuel and electricity, and high insecurity in the areas. In Mandalay, there are still power cuts, making it impossible for many to access water. Tens of thousands have been displaced and lack safe shelter, clean water and good sanitation - increasing the risk of disease outbreaks.

Caritas Norway co-operates with the Church of Myanmar, which is one of the largest civilian structures in Myanmar, and the Church is now contributing with relief work in the hardest hit areas: Mandalay, Sagaing, Shan and Bago. Many Christians, Muslims and Buddhists are now seeking refuge in our churches and open spaces. The Church has carried out rapid needs assessments and is coordinating the emergency aid. The aid provided includes food, clean water, temporary shelter, hygiene items and protection.

We ask you all to keep the dead and the injured in your prayers. Pray also for anyone who has lost a loved one, their home or their livelihood.
